# Proposal for the EYLCH in 2023.

## 1- Qualification Round,

- no modification

## 2- Regional Qualification round:

- 10 min sighting shots and 30 shots (instead for 40 shots) as at the mixed team. 12 minutes per series of 10 shots
- 3 first teams per region access to the final
- The 2 last teams receive one (1) scatt

#### 3- Final round:

### 10 teams will be qualified as follow:

- o 3 first teams from each region
- Host country (if the host country is in top 3, the 4<sup>th</sup> country for this region will be selected)

#### Semi Final format:

- 2 groups the G1 will be constituted by 1-3-5-7-9 and group 2 by 2-4-6-8-10 following the ranking results from the Regional Qualification
- The draw for T1 to T5 per group will be done at technical meeting
- 30 shots instead of 60 shots (or we keep 60 shots but will be more longer for the athletes and different with Mixed team) and the Regional qualification and the semi final will keep the same format.
- Scoring no modification
- o 4 relays per team
  - 2 relays on Friday afternoon and 2 on Saturday.

#### - Medal Match format:

- For the Gold/Silver and Bronze matches the athlete with the highest result in each shot wins two (2) individual points for his team. In case of equal results each athlete receives one (1) point.
- For the Gold/Silver and Bronze matches, the sequence will continue until one (1) team reaches a score of 61 points.

#### Awards

- The winning teams (rifle and pistol) will be European Youth League Champions.
- The winning teams will receive a commemorative trophy. (Offered by the Organizing Committee).
- The Organizing Committee of the Final must award medals for all the members (participating in final round) of the three (3) highest ranked teams in both events.
